About The Questionnaire

Who should fill it in and what is it for?

It is for you and everyone else in the Broadwindsor Group Parish. Answers from people across the Parish will help shape the Neighbourhood Development Plan. **The questionnaire is strictly anonymous** and we require no information that could identify you (if you wish, you may disregard any request on the business questionnaire, at the back, for post code or name).

It is important that everyone gets involved, including children. Space is provided at the end of the main questionnaire for children and young people to have their say. Please complete the questionnaire to make sure your views are reflected in the final document and thank you, in advance, for helping.

What Is A Neighbourhood Plan?

Neighbourhood planning has the capability to greatly influence what we would like to see being built in our Parish for the next 15 - 20 years. It also has the power to ensure that we are able to protect the things we love about our community, our buildings and our scenery.

We need to look after what we already have, whilst not forgetting that new housing and areas where employment can be encouraged are going to be needed as our population changes. A Neighbourhood Plan gives a community the tools to have a say in what should or should not be built and where development may take place.

What happens next?

Your replies will help decide the Plan for the Broadwindsor Group Parish. The Plan will go to an Independent Examiner, before being put to everyone on the Electoral Roll in a Parish referendum. If approved by a majority it will form part of the Statutory Development Plan for our area.

- * If you have a business, of whatever size, please also see the back page.
- * If you need help filling out the questionnaire, please ask (see contact details that came with it).

Most of the questions ask how strongly you feel about something, or how important something is to you, please show how you feel about something by circling a number . . .

- * For example, circling 1 shows it's not important to you, or that you really disagree, whereas circling 6 shows it's very important to you, or that you really agree a lot.
- * You may circle anything from 1 to 6.
- * Please circle just one number.
- * If you make a mistake, just put an X through it and circle the one you meant.
- * If you don't have a view on an item listed in a question you don't have to circle a score.
- * You will also find spaces for you to add any of your own thoughts or comments.
