

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH 34, BROADWINDSOR

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. **All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along footpath 34, from grid reference ST 404 030 (point A on the map below) to grid reference ST 406 039 (Point B on the map below) a distance of approximately 950 metres.** The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. **It came into operation on the 19 March 2018 for a period of 26 weeks.** But it will remain in force for 6 months and can be, extended, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

The Order is required to allow Balfour Beatty to carry out works to repair/replace the high voltage power lines for Scottish and Southern Electricity.

On this occasion there is no reasonable alternative route.
